A. <u>Appointment of Firearm Course and Instructor Development Advisory Group</u>
Pat Hahn noted that in 1999 the Board convened a Use of Force group to develop guidelines on Use of Force training. He asked for a motion for the group to be reconvened with members to be appointed by the Executive Director.

Motion was made by Duignan, seconded by Ryan, and carried by all members present to recommend the reconvening of the Use of Force Taskforce group.

#### B. <u>Tuition Increase Requests</u>

John Keigher stated Chicago Police Department submitted a tuition increase and noted they have foregone increases for the past several years. A memo, along with supporting documentation, was distributed to members showing their requested increase from \$2,500 to \$3,100. Keigher noted this figure is still low, but that it brings them closer to other academies in the region.

Motion was made by Ryan, seconded by Duignan, and carried by all members present to recommend the presented tuition increase for Chicago Police Academy.

Re: CPD Tuition Update

Several months ago, the Chicago Police Academy reached out with a request for a tuition adjustment as they have not received an increase in several years – forgoing periodic adjustments granted to other academies. After several unforeseen complications, they have now completed their analysis and supporting forms with a requested increase from \$2,508 to \$3,146 for both their CPD Academy and Metro classes. This change represents a 21% increase and is supported by a demonstration that the currently approved amount fails to meet the operational expenses of the academy.

Metro	\$2,508	\$2,979	\$3,146

Because this amount reflects an increase in the costs of operation, as well as a proportional amount to account for the additional two weeks of training under the 640-hour program, we recommend that these figures be approved for reimbursement beginning in July of 2023.
