III. RECERTIFICATION OF COURSES ~ Cheryllynn Williams

Williams read aloud the following statement: *Academy Directors must receive the Board's Executive Director's approval prior to making any changes to the 2024 schedule once it is approved.* Williams then presented the courses for approval.

Motion was made by Davis, seconded by Papaioannou, and carried by all members present to approve the list of Basic Law Enforcement Courses, Basic Corrections Courses, Part-Time Basic Law Enforcement Courses, and Other Board Courses to be certified for 2024.

IV. MANDATORY FIREARMS TRAINING ~ Cheryllynn Williams

Williams read the Mandatory Firearms Training Policy Re-Affirmation: Board approved Basic Law Enforcement, Correctional Training Academies and the Mobile Team Units are the only entities authorized to conduct the Mandatory Firearms Training Course and the Mandatory Firearms Training Waiver Course at a Board approved range.

V. IN-SERVICE, ADVANCED AND SPECIALIZED COURSES FOR CERTIFICATION/RECERTIFICATION ~ Paul Petty

Petty read the Certification/Recertification Disclaimer: *If the Mobile Team declines the delivery of any course within its region for reasons other than duplication, the Board may determine whether the course is otherwise certifiable and/or reimbursable based upon the best interests of law enforcement.*

Courses are only certified for the calendar year they are submitted, except at the Board's December quarterly meeting, courses are reviewed and certified for the following calendar year.

If modifications are made to a certified course that exceeds 10% of course content as originally presented for approval; that course must be resubmitted for certification through LETM. Please consult Board Staff whenever course revisions are made to determine if this provision is applicable.

Petty then asked for approval of the In-Service training courses submitted through the Mobile Team Units & Executive Institute for January 1, 2024 – December 31, 2024 located under Tab 10 in the Board book, this includes specialized trainings and Lead Homicide.

Motion was made by Papaioannou, seconded by Parks, and carried by all members present to approve the In-Service training courses submitted through the Mobile Team Units and the Executive Institute including courses for Specialized Trainings and Lead Homicide Investigator for January 1, 2024 – December 31, 2024.

VI. LEAD HOMICIDE INVESTIGATORS 32-HOURS APPROVED CONTINUING EDUCATION COURSES for CERTIFICATION/RECERTIFICATION ~ Paul Petty

Petty asked for approval of the Lead Homicide Investigator 32-Hour Continuing Education courses submitted for January 1, 2024 – December 31, 2024 located under Tab 10 in the Board book.

<u>Motion was made by Davis, seconded by Ryan, and carried by all members</u> present to approve the Lead Homicide Investigator <u>32-Hour Continuing</u> <u>Education courses submitted for January 1, 2024 – December 31, 2024.</u>

VII. UNFINISHED BUSINESS

A. <u>BCO Curriculum Update ~ Van Muschler</u>

Muschler noted there are automatic updates happening to BLE, BCO and Court Security. He also noted that it is recommended to increase Control Tactics from 32 to 40 hours. Officer Wellness which includes nutrition and stress [management] was added to all three curriculums, and 8-hours CIT [Concepts] was added as well. In addition, information to comply with the Pretrial Fairness Act was revised and added to all three curriculums. UIS is currently working on some additional additions to the BCO curriculum.

Motion was made by Davis, seconded by Ryan, and carried by all members present to approve the BCO Curriculum updates as presented.

B. <u>Court Security Officer Curriculum Revisions Update ~ Van Muschler</u>

Nothing added at this time.

C. <u>Department of Justice Update ~ Paul Petty</u>

Petty noted information on the DOJ courses can be found under Tab 2 at the end of the September meeting minutes. There were five courses identified to be used through the DOJ online learning COPS portal for officers in Illinois. When officers register they must have a [PTBID] number. The site will redirect Illinois officers to register to obtain their [PTBID] number. The COPS portal works much like the OLN system currently in use. More courses are being reviewed and may be added later. The portal links to our LETM system to allow officers to receive credit for courses taken. The courses will be promoted on the Boards website and through the MTU's. There will also be a small box on the DOJ website indicating it is for Illinois officers.

VIII. NEW BUSINESS

Chief Mitchell Davis stated he is on the Commission for Discrimination and Hate Crimes and they are offering training for law enforcement and other entities throughout the state in their efforts to be proactive. Davis stated he recommended the Commission bring training to the Board to hopefully help fulfill some of the SAFE-T Act mandates. Paul Petty encouraged Davis to submit the training and added that staff is currently reviewing several classes that have come in from the Attorney General's office.

Davis also suggested Heather Hotz consider offering a Chief's refresher course [through the Executive Institute].
